

WHEREAS, in Hondo, Texas, an engineering and traffic investigation has been made to determine the maximum, reasonable and prudent speeds on the section of:

FM 462 from MP 0.000 at the intersection of US 90 southerly to MP 0.963 at the south city limits for a total distance of 0.963 miles approximately.

WHEREAS, this study was initiated by the Texas Department of Transportation in response to a request by the Hondo Independent School District to add a new school zone on Avenue E (FM 462) between 26<sup>th</sup> Street and 27<sup>th</sup> Street to provide for a safe pedestrian crossing at Avenue E, a major thoroughfare, for student who must access the High School.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the engineering and traffic investigation that the maximum, reasonable and prudent speeds for the section of highway described above is 35 mph during school hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS, hereby adds a new school zone at Avenue E (FM 462) between 26<sup>th</sup> Street and 27<sup>th</sup> Street and declares and fixes the maximum, reasonable and prudent speed limits to 35 mph during school hours


All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
