

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS, ADDING ARTICLE 3.800, HOUSE AND BUILDING NUMBERING, TO CHAPTER 3 OF THE HONDO CODE OF ORDINANCES.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HONDO, TEXAS, THAT CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 3.800, HOUSE AND BUILDING NUMBERING, BE ADDED TO THE HONDO CODE OF ORDINANCES AND IS HEREBY EXPLAINED AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 3.801**

All structures within the city limits of Hondo shall be addressed and numbered. It shall be the duty of the property owner to insure proper numbering and correctly display identifying numbers on said property. All streets shall have odd numbers on the south side and even numbers on the north side. All avenues shall have odd numbers on the east side and even numbers on the west side. Other streets not designated with either a number or alphabet letter shall follow the same numbering system. All numbers shall be within four (4') feet of the front and/or rear door. The Electric Department shall be responsible for issuing all addresses in the City of Hondo.

**Section 3.802**

Numbers to be used shall be of contrasting color compared to their background. It is preferred to use black reflective numbers on a white background.

**Section 3.803**

Numbers shall be a minimum of three (3") inches tall and one and three quarter (1 ¾") inches wide.

**Section 3.804**

Any structure in excess of one hundred (100') feet from the front property line or if the landscaping makes it hard to see the number, shall have the numbers installed within ten (10) feet of the front property line on a name plate. No address number shall be obscured from view by vegetation, screening, or other means.

**Section 3.805**

All new construction will have assigned number posted correctly before a Certificate of Occupancy will be issued. Existing structures are required to comply with this ordinance by January 1, 2006.
